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

Chapter 2 Military Time Worksheet

In chapter 2 you learned how to tell military time by using the 24-hour clock instead of the 12-hour clock. In this worksheet, you will answer questions that ask you to convert from military time to regular time or vice versa. Read the exercises below and answer the questions. The correct answers are found on the last page of the workbook.


